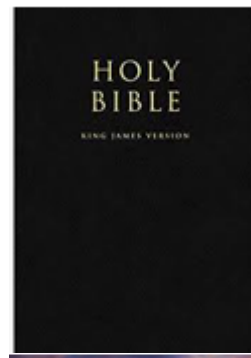


**Tier 3 Vocabulary**

- To know that some Christians believe the Lost Son shows them that God is like a parent
- Identify that some Christians shows their belief in God by worshipping him in different ways.
- Identify that forgiveness and love are key concepts in Christianity
