




## Biomes of the World

### Tier 3 Vocabulary


<b>Biome</b>	A large naturally occurring community of flora and fauna occupying a major habitat.
<b>Climate</b>	The usual weather in a place.
<b>Landscape</b>	A large area of land that you can view from one place.
<b>Animal</b>	Any living creature that can breathe and move about.
<b>Plant</b>	A living organism.
<b>Fauna</b>	The animal life of a particular area.
<b>Flora</b>	The plant life of a particular area.
<b>Climate Zone</b>	A large area with the same type of climate.
