Soul:	The spiritual part of a human being
Afterlife:	life after death
Death:	when the soul leaves the body
Reincarnation:	being born into another life
Karma:	the law of cause and effect, the idea that every action taken will have positive/negative
Moksha:	escape from the cycle of being (life-death-rebirth) as a result of Karma
Dharma:	a person's duty, the right thing to do in any given situation
Heaven:	A place regarded in many religions as the home of God.
Hell:	A place regarded in many religions as a realm of evil and suffering
Eulogy:	Honest story of a person's life including memories from whoever gives it
Perfection:	A state of being perfect
Humanist:	A follower of Humanism
Humanism:	A set of ethics or ideas about how people should live and act
