

## Tier 3 Vocabulary

Holy Week	Holy Week is the final week of Jesus's life, starting with Palm Sunday and ending with his resurrection.
disciples	A disciple is a follower, student, and close friend of Jesus who learns from him and tries to live like him.
crucifix	Jesus died on a cross called a crucifix. To Christians, a crucifix represents the way Jesus sacrificed his life for them.
tomb	A special place to put someone after they have died.
betrayal	To break the trust of someone you are close to.
temple	A special place used for worship and/or prayer.
commemorate	To honour or remember an important person or event from the past. It involves doing something special, such as having a ceremony.
resurrection	To come back to life after being dead.
