

Tier 3 Vocabulary

Theist	Someone who believes in one or more gods.
Agnostic	Someone who isn't sure whether any gods exist. They think we can't really know for sure.
Atheist	Someone who does not believe in any gods.
Religion	A set of beliefs and practices that help people understand life, behave kindly, and feel connected to something bigger than themselves.
Belief	Something you feel is true or important, even if you can't prove it
Interpretation	Explaining what something means personally
Revelation	Message from a God that helps people understand what He wants them to know or do.
Reason	Using your thinking and understanding to make sense of something, like looking at clues and using logic.
Personal Experience	Something that happens to you that makes you feel or believe something, such as feeling peaceful when you pray.
Worldviews	The way someone understands the world and makes sense of it
