Salvation	Christians believe Jesus rescues people from sin and brings them back to God.
Holy week	The last week of Jesus' life, including Palm Sunday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday.
Palm Sunday	The day Christians remember Jesus entering Jerusalem and being welcomed like a king.
Good Friday	The day Christians remember Jesus' death on the cross.
Easter Sunday	The day that Christians celebrate Jesus being resurrected from the dead.
Crucifixion	The way Jesus was killed — nailed to a wooden cross.
Resurrection	Christians believe Jesus came back to life on Easter Sunday.
Forgiveness	Letting go of anger when someone has done something wrong.
Sacrifice	Giving up something important to help others. Christians believe Jesus' death was a sacrifice.
Belief	Something a person thinks is true, especially about God.

- Holy week is the last week of Jesus' life that Christians remember in the week before Easter Sunday
- Palm Sunday is the day when Jesus entered Jerusalem on a donkey and was welcomed by the crowds.
- Good Friday is the day Jesus was crucified on a cross. Christians mark this day with quiet reflective worship.
- Easter Sunday is the day Christians believe Jesus was resurrected from the dead. Christians celebrate this day in joyful worship
- Good Friday is called "good" because Christians believe Jesus' death rescues them from sin and brings them back to God.
