

Tier 3 Vocabulary (Domain specific vocabulary)

Jesus	Believed to be the son of God. His name means God saves.
Palm Sunday	A Christian celebration of when Jesus entered Jerusalem.
Saviour/rescuer	Someone who rescues, helps or saves a person from harm/trouble.
Hosanna	Means 'save us' in Hebrew
Good Friday	The day Christians remember Jesus' death on the cross.
Easter Sunday	The day that Christians celebrate Jesus coming back to life.
Tomb	A resting place for someone who has died.
Supper	A meal eaten at the end of the day.

Children in EYFS will **begin** to understand some of the main beliefs and practices of Christianity. It is not necessary for children to grasp the 'big story', but it may help the teacher to see where the core concepts of Creation, Incarnation and Salvation fit.

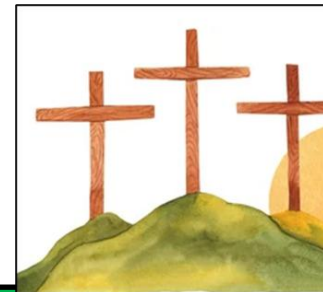
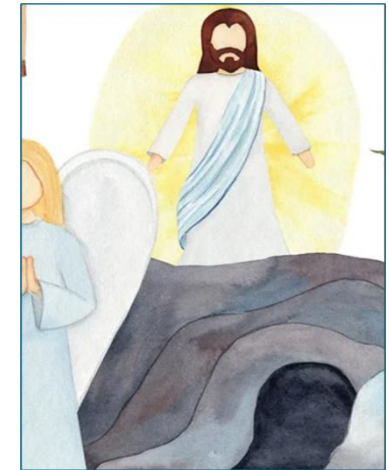

Key Facts

Holy Week is a special week when Christians remember the last things Jesus did before Easter.

Palm Sunday remembers the day Jesus rode into a city on a donkey and people waved palm branches to welcome him.

Good Friday remembers the day Jesus died

Easter Sunday celebrates that Christians believe Jesus came alive again. It is a happy day at church.

Good Friday is called "good" because Christians believe Jesus helped everyone by showing God's love.
